Reading (Pa) July 31, 1778 from Jacob Morgan to Col. Henry Spicker (Spyker) or "The Next in Command"

[Not sure if this is Col. or Capt. Morgan, father or son ? The father laid out the site of Morgantown, Pa.]

Reading (Pa) April 12, 1779 from L.Lt. Valentine Eckert and L.L. Henry Shoemaker to Col. Henry Spyker, Tulpehocken  
Letter opened, read and added to by Benjamin Morgan in the absence of his father (?)

Reading (Pa) Sept 23, 1783 from Benjamin Spyker to Col. Henry Spyker, Tulpehocken (brother to brother)  
[Col. Henry Spyker was paymaster of the Berks Co. militia during the Revolutionary War. His family came over from Germany in 1710 with the family of Conrad Weiser. He later settled in Lewisburg in 1797, became a shopkeeper and was appointed Justice of the Peace until his death in 1817. He built the first brick house ever-erected in Lewisburg, which still stands at the corner of Front and St. Catherine streets.]
